Silas hoards a treasure that kills his spirit until fate steals it from him and replaces it with a golden-haired founding child. Where she came from, who her parents were, and who really stole the gold are the secrets that permeate this moving tale of quilt and innocence. A moral allegory of the redemptive power of love, it is also a finely drawn picture of early nineteenthcentury England in the days when spinning wheels hummed busily in the farmhouses, and of a simple way of life that was soon to disappear.
