Wednesday Morning Prayer Service and Communion Every Wednesday – 7 AM – Sanctuary

John Wesley said, "It is the duty of every Christian to receive the Lord's Supper as often as he or she can." Wesley called Holy Communion "the grand channel" of God's grace to us; grace being nothing less than empowerment and pardon made possible by God's very presence with us. Christ is present at the table. When Christ said, "I have longed desired to share this meal with you," his words are as much for us today as they were for the disciples so long ago.

Furthermore, Christ also told us that miracles cannot happen without prayer. For this reason, the sacrament of Holy Communion and the power of prayer are vital ways that we connect with the Triune God, "becoming one with Christ, one with each other, and one in ministry to all the world." These Means of Grace are two of the vital ways that we become "Holy as Christ is Holy."

We are at a critical point in history in which Christ is asking us to be His Bride. Although a part of the world, we stand apart from the world. We cannot be his disciples, nor his church, if we do not pray and receive Holy Communion as often as we possibly can.

Revival and Holy Communion go hand in hand. Wesley believed that when we receive Christ, our lives are transformed. Over and over again in his journal we see examples of God working mightily as the faithful gathered for Holy Communion, prayed together, and received Christ together.

I know that you feel the very power and presence of the Holy Spirit in our church. The Spirit is hovering over the waters of our baptism as He did so long ago at the precipice of creation. We know that God is about to work a tremendous miracle, but are you prepared?

Each Wednesday we have a prayer and communion service from 7:00 AM until 7:35 AM. We are asking our congregation to make every possible effort to attend this service, especially as we enter into a season of discernment regarding the future of our church. As I said, we all know that the Holy Spirit is doing something miraculous in our church, but the Spirit needs us to put on the full armor of Christ in order to receive His Word and act on His Will.

Will you join Steve and me as we pray for the vision Christ has placed within us, and within our church. Let us feast together with Christ as the Holy Spirit guides us into fully transformed lives who worship passionately, love extravagantly, and witness boldly.

LA MAGDALENA CHRISTIAN SCHOOL - HERE WE GROW!



The construction work continues for the much needed new classroom building at the school we sponsor in La Magdalena, El Salvador. We are

excited to share with you the recently received complete site plan for the entire school, showing what the school will look like when all construction and infrastructure is completed. (See Link Below) The section in green is the recently acquired property, with the set of four classrooms currently under construction shown on the right of that property. The set of classrooms shown on the left will be future construction, as funds are raised. Also, there is currently not a multi-purpose athletic field as shown on the site plan (also required by the government), but rather just a grassy field with fissures in the hard, volcanic earth during the current dry season.
