One Child El Salvador

We are blessed to have such dedicated teachers and staff at the La Magdalena Christian School. They love the students and they love God. They are very happy to be a part of what God is doing in their school.



Our teachers need your support and prayers. Please remember them in your daily prayers. Pray for good health and safe travels to and from the school. Pray for their success as educators, continuing to guide students with integrity and kindness.

Pray for good relationships between students, parents, and teachers; and prayers for a close walk with Jesus, recognizing the Holy Spirit's guidance each day.



The cost of living is much lower in El Salvador than here in the United States. A significant percentage of the population falls below the poverty line. The average individual living wage is about \$325/month. There are few career choices available outside of sugar cane and coffee.

To be a teacher in this economic environment is truly a sacrifice of love. The total monthly disbursement for teacher salaries at our school is just under \$8,000. That doesn't sound like much but we struggle each month to raise the funds to cover it. Our school is funded solely by your donations. There are no grants or federal assistance. Your donations make a difference in the lives of these teachers! When you give a reoccurring monthly financial gift of any amount, it gives our teachers peace of mind that they can continue making a living doing what they love. In their hearts, teaching at La Magdalena is fulfilling God's call on their life.



Lorena Garcia is one of our new teachers this year. She teaches English for the 3rd, 4th, and 6th grades. She tells us that she feels blessed to be working at a place where God is the pilar in education. Lorena says that as teachers, we guide the students into the learning path, but at this school, we also have the opportunity to share with them God's salvation; I feel grateful to be part of that.

LA MAGDALENA CHRISTIAN SCHOOL - HERE WE GROW!



The construction work continues for the much needed new classroom building at the school we sponsor in La Magdalena, El Salvador. We are

excited to share with you the recently received complete site plan for the entire school, showing what the school will look like when all construction and infrastructure is completed. (See Link Below) The section in green is the recently acquired property, with the set of four classrooms currently under construction shown on the right of that property. The set of classrooms shown on the left will be future construction, as funds are raised. Also, there is currently not a multi-purpose athletic field as shown on the site plan (also required by the government), but rather just a grassy field with fissures in the hard, volcanic earth during the current dry season.
