



Book Club September Reading Selection



The Book Club will be discussing The Martyr's Oath: Living for the Jesus They're willing to Die For by Johnnie Moore, Wednesday, Sept. 20th at 6:30pm in the Library.

Be Inspired by Amazing Eyewitness Stories of Hope and Courage from the Persecuted Church. We are witnessing an astonishing escalation in Christian persecution like we have rarely seen since the first century. Some estimate that every five minutes, a Christian is martyred for his or her faith. Countries like Egypt have experienced more Christian persecution in the last five years than in the previous six hundred years combined. And who could have missed the atrocities of ISIS in Syria, Boko Haram in Nigeria, and the continued persecution of Christians in North Korea? Johnnie Moore, like many American Christians, didn't fully appreciate the extent of what was going on-until he witnessed the graduation of theology students in India. Unlike graduation ceremonies in America—where feel-good speeches made by visiting celebrities are common—this one featured a remarkable oath. It wasn't an oath to excel or succeed. It was an

temporal.
Johnnie knew he was witnessing a raw, first-century Christianity that his comfortable American version had shielded him from. "For the first time, I really understand my faith," says Johnnie Moore. Now, he's on a mission to give this same experience to others. He and his team have crisscrossed the world, recorders in hand, gathering eyewitness accounts from dozens of people who survived persecution—and the

LA MAGDALENA CHRISTIAN SCHOOL - HERE WE GROW!



The construction work continues for the much needed new classroom building at the school we sponsor in La Magdalena, El Salvador. We are

excited to share with you the recently received complete site plan for the entire school, showing what the school will look like when all construction and infrastructure is completed. (See Link Below) The section in green is the recently acquired property, with the set of four classrooms currently under construction shown on the right of that property. The set of classrooms shown on the left will be future construction, as funds are raised. Also, there is currently not a multi-purpose athletic field as shown on the site plan (also required by the government), but rather just a grassy field with fissures in the hard, volcanic earth during the current dry season.


